



10 January - One Life (12A) 2023 **UK**
1hr 50mins
 Anthony Hopkins plays London broker Nicholas "Nicky" Winton who helps rescue hundreds of predominantly Jewish children from Czechoslovakia in a race against time before the Nazi occupation closes the borders. Fifty years later, he's still haunted by the fate of those he wasn't able to bring to safety.



14 February - The Holdovers (15) 2023 **USA**
2hr 14mins
 One of the funniest films you'll watch this year. A curmudgeonly instructor at a New England school remains on campus during Christmas break. He soon forms an unlikely bond with a brainy but damaged troublemaker, and with the school's cook, a woman who just lost a son in the Vietnam War.



14 March - The Taste of Things (12A) 2023 **France**

 Juliette Binoche and Benoît Magimel share a delicate chemistry in a French culinary romance concerning the relationship between Eugénie, an esteemed cook, and Dodin, the gourmet she has been working for over the last 20 years. Growing fonder of one another, their bond turns into a romance and gives rise to delicious dishes that impress even the world's most illustrious chefs.



11 April - Honeyland (15) 2019 **Macedonia**

 Hatidze Muratova lives with her ailing mother in a village without roads, electricity or running water. She's the last in a long line of wild beekeepers, eking out a living farming honey in small batches to be sold in the closest city – a mere 4 hours walk away. Hatidze's peaceful existence is thrown into upheaval by the arrival of an itinerant family, with their roaring engines, seven rambunctious children and herd of cattle.



9 May - The Room Next Door (12A) 2024 **Spain**
1hr 47mins
 Ingrid (Julianne Moore) and Martha (Tilda Swinton) were close friends in their youth, when they worked together at the same magazine. Ingrid went on to become an autofiction novelist while Martha became a war reporter, and they were separated by the circumstances of life. After years of being out of touch, they meet again in an extreme but strangely sweet situation.



13 June - The Critic (15) 2023 **UK**
1hr 41mins
 Sir Ian McKellen luxuriates in the role of Jimmy Erskine, longtime theatre critic at The London Chronicle, whose position is threatened after the death of his former editor and mentor, who's been replaced by his more conservative son. To save his own skin, Jimmy manipulates the actor he's always written about with disdain, Nina Land, into a scheme that begins with blackmail and ends with murder.

 Soak up the sun, take it easy, recharge those batteries & look forward to the exciting return of the film club programme in September.....



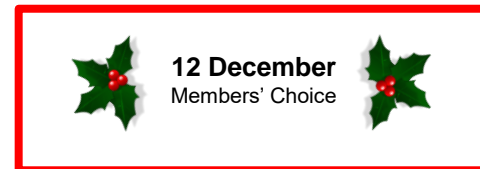
12 September - Anatomy of a Fall (15) 2023 **France**

10 October - Fremont (12A) 2023 **USA**
